

at home Artist residency



The At Home Residency Program (AHR) is designed to creatively and financially support **THREE** artists through the COVID-19 pandemic. Artists will be paid a subsistence fee to create a body of work at home which will be shown in a virtual exhibition. Artists of all levels are encouraged to apply.

The AHR program provides the artist with:

- Three remote mentorship sessions with interdisciplinary artist and Emily Carr University of Art +Design alumna Haley Bassett
- Subsistence fee of \$100 per week for a eight-week working period (\$800 total)
- A curated virtual exhibition
- Free admission to one workshop held a DCAG (\$75 value)
- Free South Peace Arts Society membership renewal

Eligibility Guidelines:

- Artist must reside in Northeastern BC
- Artist must be a member of the South Peace Arts Society. To become a member call the Dawson Creek Art Gallery at 250 782 2601.

Application Guidelines:

1. Curriculum Vitae (maximum three pages)
2. Description of proposed work intended for the residency (maximum one page)
3. Artist Bio and Statement (150 words maximum for each)
4. 5-10 images (a maximum of 1 MB file size each, jpeg format with a resolution of 72dpi at 1024 x 768 pixels) of recent work related to the residency proposal. Images must be labeled with a number_title_lastname (example: 01_Nemo_Smith).
5. Image List with image numbers, artist name, title of work and date, medium and dimensions

How to Submit your Application:

1. Send application by email attachments to programs@dcartgallery.ca. Documents must be in Word or PDF format, and images in JPG format
2. Deadline for application is January 20th 2021

Applications will be assessed by a jury according to the following criteria:



Artistic Merit

- The artistic quality of your work
- The artistic rationale for your project
- The potential artistic outcomes

Impact

The potential of the project to:

- Contribute to your artistic development
- Advance your artistic practice

Feasibility

- Your capacity and experience to undertake the project
